



# Growing Deeper in Christ Together (Psalms)

The book of Psalms should be read with the heart and not just the mind. The Psalms inspire us to commit to God through surrender, to find comfort in God through lament and complaint, and to receive mercy from God through confession and repentance. They give us an eternal perspective and help us to find strength in Him through praise and hope.

These psalms are the prayers and songs of believers through the ages. It is the book of the Bible that Jesus quoted more than any other. The Psalms ultimately draw us closer to our Saviour.

This one-chapter-per-day<sup>1</sup> Bible reading plan will walk through all 150 psalms themed around the early kingship of Israel, the fall of the kingdom and the eventual return of the King. A special Easter week reading will feature passages in the Psalms quoted by Jesus. Where possible, David's psalms are generally set in the context of the history of Israel and the events of his life, thereby giving us a rare glimpse into both the outward actions and inner life of David.

Finally, this reading plan is accompanied by a selection of songs based on the passages as they appear in the plan (please scan the QR code).
